

Guidance for Travelling to Ulverston Health Centre

Able-bodied People

If you live in Ulverston or are travelling from elsewhere, and are reasonably fit, please make every effort not to drive all the way to the Health Centre. The car park is not very big and gets congested. Consider walking from your home, taking the bus, or parking in one of the nearby pay-and-display public car parks.

Please refer to the Ulverston Town Map on ulverston.com/resources for public car park locations. The Health Centre is marked as number 2 on the map. Closest car parks are at The Gill or Buxton Place (entered from Fountain Street). Stockbridge Lane is also a short walking distance away, but there is a flight of steps to negotiate between Stockbridge Lane and The Gill. Please do not attempt to park in Stanley Street or any of the nearby residential streets.

If you refer to the Covid Vaccinations Site Layout, also on ulverston.com/resources, you will see an aerial view of the Health Centre. If arriving on foot, please enter from Stanley Street, and walk straight ahead via the pavement, following the white arrows on the map, until you reach the **Queue**.

Less-Able-Bodied People

The Health Centre operates on weekdays for GP surgeries and clinics, and the first section of the car park, marked on the plan as **Health Centre**, is needed for patients using those services.

If you need to arrive by car, enter the site via Stanley Street, and follow the green arrows on the site plan to the **Vaccinations** parking spaces. There will be stewards and signage to assist. Please try to follow the one-way system when in the vaccinations area of the car park, to minimise congestion and reduce risk to pedestrians.

If you are a blue badge holder and can only walk very short distances, or if you have a wheelchair or walking aid, please go to the **Blue Badge and Dropoff** area shown on the Site Layout. You will be able to join the vaccinations queue at the **Gazebo**, next to the clinic **Entrance**.

Further parking is available for carers and service drivers in the **Patient Transport waiting** area, behind the Gill Rise building.

If you arrive by patient transport, we recommend that you exchange mobile phone numbers if possible, so that you can call your driver after being vaccinated. Your driver will be able to collect you at the area marked **Pickup only**, next to the Health Centre **Exit**.

There are **Parking spaces for stewards**, at the front of the Gill Rise building.

To leave the site, follow the red arrows.

Please do not park on any of the double yellow lines. Do not park in the **NHS Staff** spaces or at the Health Centre Main Entrance, marked as **Keep Clear**, as access must be maintained for dealing with emergencies.

Finally, when you leave the Health Centre site by car, we request that you turn left into Stanley Street. In most cases you would then turn right at Garden Terrace, and then either left or right at Soutergate, depending on your destination.
